**Fish Follies** is open to all artists 18+ working in all media. Our theme is anything fishy! Oceans, water, fishing, or seafood related.

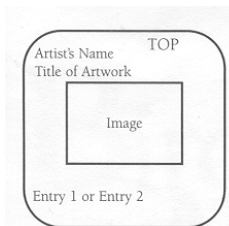
**Juror:** The Cordova Museum is pleased to announce this year's juror, Alaska fisherman and wood carver **Mike Webber**. Mike is an Alaska native, born and raised in Cordova. His carvings are in museums throughout the state and private collections nation wide. Mike's carvings reflect his Alutiiq and Tlingit heritage.

## Specifications:

- No one dimension shall exceed 72 inches nor exceed 50 lbs.
- All work must have been executed in 2007, 2008 or 2009.
- All works submitted must be for sale. No work shall have been previously exhibited at the Cordova Museum.

## Entry Procedures:

- All entries must be postmarked by April 25, 2009. Please note: First class only. NO GROUND, THIRD CLASS OR FED EX. UPS OR USPS PRIORITY MAIL ONLY. (This is Alaska! Ground and Fed Ex are unreliable here)
- A maximum of two works may be entered per artist.
- Two images per work may be submitted.
- We accept digital images via CD or email, (300 dpi, 8"x10", jpegs only, under 1MB) or professional quality slides.
- All images must be labeled with the artist's name, title of artwork, entry number (Entry 1 or Entry 2) and TOP.
- A \$25.00 processing fee payable in U.S. dollars must accompany the entry form, A \$30.00 fee will be charged for any check returned for non-sufficient funds.



## Notification:

- All artists submitting entries will be notified by May 9th by mail, email or phone of selection decisions.
- Slides of artwork will be returned to the artist with notification letter or shortly thereafter.
- The Museum reserves the right not to display any selected work that does not correspond to the quality or configuration indicated in the submitted slides.

## Artists' Responsibilities:

- Mounting, matting and framing are the responsibility of the artist. Sculpture or 3D pieces must be ready for display.
- Artists are responsible for shipping work to the museum. Artists are responsible for all crating costs.

## Museum Responsibilities:

- The Museum will cover return shipping costs.
- The Museum pays all costs associated with wall-to-wall fine arts insurance.
- The Museum provides opening reception, jurors talk and all publicity.
- Cordova Museum retains 30% of sale price on pieces sold.

## Prizes Awarded:

- Spectacular Alaska Wild Seafood prizes will be awarded!! Best of Show, 2nd Place, Three Honorable Mentions, and "**Most Fishy**".
