

**CITY OF CORDOVA, ALASKA
ORDINANCE 1075**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORDOVA,
ALASKA, WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT IN CMC 11.20.110(i) FOR ALASKA
DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME TO PETITION AND RECEIVE APPROVAL
FOR THEIR BUILDING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FROM THE CORDOVA
PLANNING COMMISSION, AND APPROVING THE PLANS AND
SPECIFICATIONS AS PRESENTED TO CITY COUNCIL, AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Cordova, Alaska, that:


Section 1. The Council finds that the original plan for upgrading the Alaska Department of Fish and Game's Cordova Dock was harmful to the public peace, health or safety of the citizens of Cordova, and that an expeditious approval of an amended plan is critical to maintain public peace and safety. The Council therefore finds that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety, and that it should become effective prior to the time when an ordinary ordinance would become effective.

Section 2: The Council hereby waives the requirement set forth in CMC 11.20.110(i) for Alaska Department of Fish and Game to petition and receive approval for their building plans and specifications from the Cordova Planning Commission, and hereby approves the amended plans and specifications as presented to Council and attached to this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage in accordance with Section 2.13 of the Charter of the City of Cordova, Alaska and published in the Cordova Times, a newspaper of general circulation, within ten (10) days of its passage.
