A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORDOVA, ALASKA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT WITH CONSTRUCTION MACHINERY INDUSTRIAL, LLC, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING AN EMERGENCY BACKUP PORTABLE GENERATOR FOR THE CITY OF CORDOVA

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Homeland Security, under the 2019 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSP), awarded the City of Cordova a Grant of \$26,500 to purchase an Emergency Portable Generator on a towable Trailer; and

WHEREAS, CMI is a State recognized vendor of Commercial Grade Generators and has extensive experience working with the state and local officials; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cordova has used CMI on previous SHSP Grants as the Sole Source Vendor to purchase an emergency towable generator within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the self-contained portable generator is fully compatible and functionally seamless with the additional Cordova Emergency Backup Generator, and recognized City Emergency Shelters; and

WHEREAS, no additional equipment or training will be needed to be purchased or installed by additional companies or vendors to be necessary for full compatibility within our organization saving our community future funds; and

WHEREAS, this request meets the provisions of the Cordova Municipal Code in Section 5.12.040 - Council approval of contracts. No contract for supplies, services or construction which obligates the city to pay more than twenty-five thousand dollars may be executed unless the council has approved a memorandum setting forth the following essential terms of the contract: and Section 5.12.150 (a)(5) - providing for sole source procurements for professional services.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Cordova, Alaska hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Construction Machinery Industrial, LLC., for purchasing a portable trailer mounted self-contained unit, shipping, associated equipment and materials for the City of Cordova in an amount not to exceed \$26,500.
