CITY OF CORDOVA, ALASKA RESOLUTION 03-14-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY CORDOVA, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY 14 BUDGET TO RECOGNIZE THE RECEIPT OF \$300,645.39 FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO REIMBURSE THE CITY FOR EXPENSES INCURRED DURING THE 2012 SNOW EVENT AND TO APPROPRIATE UP TO \$95,000 TO FUND THE ACQUISITION OF A PIECE OF ASPHALT PATCHING EQUIPMENT AND A DOUBLE DRUM ROLLER TO FULFILL THE CITY'S ROAD MAINTENANCE PROGRAM FOR 2014

WHEREAS, in 2012 there was a significant snow event that caused the City leaders of Cordova to spend several hundreds of thousands of dollars to remove snow and support the citizens of this community; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Homeland Security for the State of Alaska has advised that approximately \$300,000 has been earmarked to reimburse the City for said expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the Raytech Dual Axle Mounted Reclaimer is a time-tested, proven piece of equipment that will provide the City with road repair and patching capability it currently does not possess, especially in inclement weather; and

WHEREAS, the staff of the City recommends that the City Council appropriate up to \$95,000 from snow event money prior to the remainder being placed in the City's General Fund account.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Cordova, Alaska does hereby amend the FY14 budget to recognize the receipt of \$300,645.39 from the Department of Homeland Security to reimburse the City from expenses incurred during the 2012 snow event and to appropriate up to \$95,000 to fund the acquisition of a piece of asphalt patching equipment and a double drum to fulfill the City's road maintenance program for 2014.
