



Skaters Cabin - Rules and Regulations

Inside Skaters Cabin:

1. During your stay at the cabin please lock the door when you are not present.
 - The City of Cordova Parks and Recreation Department will not be held responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged personal items.
2. All garbage should be contained inside the cabin or in the outdoor trash receptacle on the deck of the cabin.
 - The outdoor trash receptacle is emptied Monday through Friday by the Parks and Recreation staff on an as needed basis.
 - Please do not put trash from your stay in the trash receptacle on the beachfront as this is provided for public use.
 - There is no trash can inside the cabin. Renters will need to supply their own trash bags and carry out excess garbage acquired during their stay.
 - Do not burn garbage in the fireplace or outdoor fire pit. Wood and paper products only please.
3. The fireplace / fire pit should be used only when the cabin is occupied.
 - Please extinguish all fires if you are planning on leaving the cabin and /or beach area during your stay.
4. Please respect this cabin.
 - All provided furniture and equipment supplied within the cabin should remain inside the cabin and be left in the condition it was found.
 - Do not tamper with the cabin itself or cause any type of harm or destruction. All damages will be incurred at the renter's expense.
5. No alcohol is to be consumed on or in this property.
6. Please call the Cordova Police Department at 424-6100 with any concerns you may have during your stay that may require the necessary attention.



Skaters Cabin Beachfront

Open Beach 11am – 7pm

1. The outdoor area of the cabin and its surrounding area should be left in a clean and tidy manner always.
 - All trash should be contained inside the cabin or in the outdoor trash receptacle.
 - All food items should be properly sealed and secured when not in use outdoors and placed inside the cabin overnight or anytime when the renter is not present at the cabin.
2. Campfires must be contained in the provided fire pit.
 - Loose firewood may be collected from the surrounding area.
 - Firewood is not provided but can be purchased from the Bidarki Recreation Center when available.
 - Wood and paper products only in the fire pit. Please do not burn foreign objects such as metal, glass or plastic.
 - Pallet fires are not permitted. The nails left behind pose a safety issue to those recreating on the beach.
3. Please help us keep our beach safe, clean and free of all debris.
 - This beach is a public swimming area. It is a combined effort between the Parks and Recreation Department and the renters/community user group of this area to keep it clean and safe for all types of recreation related to this property.
 - Swim at your own risk there is no lifeguard attending this area. All young children must be supervised by an adult while utilizing the beachfront area.
4. Watercraft.
 - Non- motorized watercraft traffic is welcome to launch and moor at Skaters Cabin anywhere on the beach during the hours of 11am-7pm; if you are renting the cabin you are allowed 24-hour access.
 - Motorized watercraft can moor on the property in designated areas (indicated via signage) during the hours of 11am-7pm. If you are renting the cabin you are granted 24-hour access and mooring on the beach in the designated areas.
 - Motorized watercraft are not allowed to launch anywhere on the property. There is a boat launch located on at the end of the City airstrip.
 - Motorized watercraft must abide by the no wake rule within 50 feet of the shore while approaching the beach to moor (in the designated areas).

5. The outhouse is provided for your comfort and convenience. Please use it.
 - Please call the Parks and Recreation Administrative Offices if the outhouse needs to be tended to @ 424-7282 M-F, 10am – 6pm.
 - The Parks Maintenance staff will tend to the outhouse once a day, in the mornings, M-F.
6. Fishing for or harassing salmon in Eyak Lake is strictly **PROHIBITED**. Check ADF&G regulations for other species.
 - If you fish elsewhere and filet your fish at Skaters Cabin; do not clean your catch in the cabin.
 - You can filet fish on the beach, however, you cannot dispose any part of the carcass in the lake nor are you allowed to leave any part of the carcass on the beach overnight; this could attract unwanted visitors to the beach front and pose a safety threat to yourself and/or others in the area.
 - There are several fish cleaning stations in Cordova. Both the North and South Harbor have a fish cleaning station with ample room and hoses to clean you catch. There is also a fish cleaning station at Shelter Cove right off Orca Rd; (on the inlet side) you can't miss it.
7. The cleaning and or butchering / processing of moose or deer (any wild game) inside the Cabin or outside on the property is prohibited.
 - Skaters Cabin is not equipped with running water to clean or sanitize any areas that may be affected by this type of activity which creates a health safety issue.
 - Hanging deer or moose overnight on the beach could attract unwanted visitors and poses a safety threat to you and any others in the area.

The parking area in front of the Skaters Cabin is reserved for rental customers. Public is welcome to utilize the parking lot on the right just ahead of the cabin.
