June 2022 CEO Board Report

Healthcare workforce shortages continue to contribute to stress and expense of our operations. Recruitment and retention for positions that require specific licensing and training is particularly difficult. CCMC continues to be aggressive in promoting work life balance and employee satisfaction, we are creative with our employment and staffing arrangements and yet we continue to struggle to maintain our workforce. Turnover continues to be very costly for our facility.

Services

Clinic

Volumes are at baseline and continue to improve. Specialty clinics continue as previous and area great asset for our community.

Sound Alternatives

We continue to recruit for a therapist as well as a community case manager. Staff are working hard to maintain services despite the shortages.

Rehabilitation

Our rehab services expansion has gone well. I continue to hear from the community positive feed back regarding the staff and services provided. We are working on advertising to ensure providers, hospitals and community members are aware of the broad range of services we provide. These include vestibular rehabilitation to improve balance, coordination, vertigo and reduce risk of falls as well as orthopedic post-op for all upper and lower extremity joints. In occupational therapy our therapists create programs that are client-centered, focused on education and support while assisting in restoring function across the lifespan. Occupational therapy is also frequently recommended for children who are experiencing developmental delays, sensory processing deficits or school-based concerns. Please help us ensure that community members know our services are available and can choose in person, hands on therapy as opposed to remote tele services that Cordova has historically utilized.

Administrative:

We have submitted our cost report and expect to have a positive settlement when that is finalized. For our operations, like other departments, the business office thinly staffed. This month we are bidding farewell to our longest CCMC business office employee, Carol Roemhildt, who is retiring! We continue to evaluate business and revenue cycle maximize the hospital's financial security.

TELEMEDICINE PRIVILEGES (Delegated)

Telemedicine privileges for consult services are provided by organizations contracted with Cordova Community Medical Center. Process for credential verification and privileges is delegated to the contracted entity. Quality improvement is also monitored and maintained by the contracted entity.

To be eligible to apply for telemedicine specialty consult privileges at CCMC, the initial applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Degree: MD or DO, PA or NP
- Successful completion of a residency or fellowship training program approved by the specialty specific governing board
- Maintain active privileges with a contracted organization, with copy of privileges provided to Cordova Community Medical Center.
- Participate in quality improvement and peer review through contracted organization

Telemedicine privileges may be granted to a practitioner pursuant to credentialing performed by the distant site hospital, distant site telemedicine entity, or through credentialing performed by the Hospital.

If a practitioner's credentialing and privileging are performed under a contractual agreement with a distant site hospital or distant site telemedicine entity and the Hospital terminates its telemedicine agreement with the distant site hospital or distant site telemedicine entity, the practitioner's telemedicine privileges will automatically terminate.

Telemedicine privileges shall be for a period of not more than two years.

CCMC's peer review committee will maintain evidence of its internal peer review of the distant site hospital. CCMC's peer review committee will send information related to all adverse events that result from the telemedicine services provided by the distant site hospital or distant site telemedicine entity practitioner to a Hospital patient and all complaints the

Hospital has received about a distant site hospital or distant site telemedicine entity practitioner. Any information exchanged between the Hospital and a distant site hospital or distant site telemedicine entity in connection with a distant site hospital or distant site telemedicine entity practitioner's credentialing or performance will be handled by the CCMC's peer review committee.

All telemedicine practitioners will be categorized as "telemedicine staff" and will not be eligible to vote or hold office. Practitioners will follow other medical staff or hospital requirements that apply only to practitioners that provide direct patient care.

Please provide a copy of credential and privileges from the contracted organization along with this application.

Acknowledgement of Practitioner

I have requested privileges for telemedicine practitioner in Diagnostic Radiology (field of specialty). I have only requested those privileges for which by education, training, current experience, and demonstrated performance I am qualified to perform and for which I wish to exercise via telemedicine on behalf of Cordova Community Medical Center. 

TELEMEDICINE PRIVILEGES (Delegated)

Telemedicine privileges for consult services are provided by organizations contracted with Cordova Community Medical Center. Process for credential verification and privileges is delegated to the contracted entity. Quality improvement is also monitored and maintained by the contracted entity.

To be eligible to apply for telemedicine specialty consult privileges at CCMC, the initial applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Degree: MD or DO, PA or NP
- Successful completion of a residency or fellowship training program approved by the specialty specific governing board
- Maintain active privileges with a contracted organization, with copy of privileges provided to Cordova Community Medical Center.
- Participate in quality improvement and peer review through contracted organization

Telemedicine privileges may be granted to a practitioner pursuant to credentialing performed by the distant site hospital, distant site telemedicine entity, or through credentialing performed by the Hospital.

If a practitioner's credentialing and privileging are performed under a contractual agreement with a distant site hospital or distant site telemedicine entity and the Hospital terminates its telemedicine agreement with the distant site hospital or distant site telemedicine entity, the practitioner's telemedicine privileges will automatically terminate.

Telemedicine privileges shall be for a period of not more than two years.

CCMC's peer review committee will maintain evidence of its internal peer review of the distant site hospital. CCMC's peer review committee will send information related to all adverse events that result from the telemedicine services provided by the distant site hospital or distant site telemedicine entity practitioner to a Hospital patient and all complaints the

Hospital has received about a distant site hospital or distant site telemedicine entity practitioner. Any information exchanged between the Hospital and a distant site hospital or distant site telemedicine entity in connection with a distant site hospital or distant site telemedicine entity practitioner's credentialing or performance will be handled by the CCMC's peer review committee.

All telemedicine practitioners will be categorized as "telemedicine staff" and will not be eligible to vote or hold office. Practitioners will follow other medical staff or hospital requirements that apply only to practitioners that provide direct patient care.






