WHEREAS, no City funds are requested for this project and the Cordova Covered Spaces Project will provide any matching funds required by the State of Alaska Transportation Alternatives Program,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the City of Cordova, Alaska supports an application for site restoration funding by the Cordova Covered Spaces Project to the State of Alaska Transportation Alternatives Program for funds to complete this site restoration work.
