POSITION SUMMARY:	The crossing guard is responsible for safely guiding pedestrians and harbor users across designated crosswalks during construction times.
QUALIFICATIONS:	They must possess excellent communication skills, patience, and attentiveness to always ensure safety.

DUTIES:

- Safely guide pedestrians and harbor users across designated intersections or cross walks.
- Stop vehicular traffic using stop signs or hand signals as appropriate.
- Communicate effectively with drivers, pedestrians, and all harbor users.
- Maintain visibility by wearing reflective gear and standing in clearly marked locations. Gear will be provided.
- Collaborate with contractors, harbor employees, and all users as needed.

WORKING CONDITIONS: Much of the work is performed outdoors, sometimes in inclement weather. Work is performed within a construction area.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: Capable of walking, standing, hearing, seeing, and communicating.
