RESOLUTION 04-26-18**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORDOVA, ALASKA,
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A SOLE SOURCE
EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT CONTRACT WITH DXP ALASKA PUMP & SUPPLY
INC., TO PURCHASE A DEMING PUMP & MOTOR ASSEMBLY, FOR THE
WASTEWATER DIVISION'S IMMEDIATE NEED AT THE EYAK SEWER LIFT STATION**

WHEREAS, the primary Eyak Sewer Lift Station pump was damaged beyond repair; and

WHEREAS, the Eyak Sewer Lift Station is currently functioning only with its backup pump;
and

WHEREAS, if the backup pump becomes damaged the lift station would become nonfunctioning and could create health, safety, and welfare issues that would put the community at risk;
and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to authorize the City Manager to enter into a sole source emergency procurement contract to acquire a new primary pump for the Eyak Sewer Lift Station; and

WHEREAS, City Council does hereby approve the following as required in Cordova Municipal Code Section 7.10.040 Council approval of contracts:

- A. Contractor: ***DXP Alaska Pump & Supply INC***
- B. Contract price: ***\$50,874.00***
- C. Nature and quantity of the performance that the City shall receive:
One (1) Deming Pump & Motor Assembly
- D. Time for performance: ***Immediately***; and

WHEREAS pursuant to Cordova Municipal Code Section 7.10.160, the City Manager has determined in writing that, due to potential for an immediate health, safety, and welfare issue being created should the backup pump at the Eyak Lift Station fail, City Council agrees in approving this resolution that the city requirements are being met with a sole source emergency procurement contract with DXP Alaska Pump & Supply INC.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the City of Cordova, Alaska, hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a sole source emergency procurement contract with DXP Alaska Pump & Supply INC, to purchase a Deming Pump & Motor Assembly.
