**DISCUSSION ITEMS**

- 1) Committee Member Appointments/Terms: City Council has approved the addition of a 7<sup>th</sup> member and of terms. Will have the city advertise the 7<sup>th</sup> position. Terms will start in November. Dave Zastrow and Liz Senear's terms will be up for appointment in November
- 2) Odiak Pond Trail: Discussed Ducks Unlimited as a possible grantor. Will invite Brant Mixel to the next meeting. Liz Senear will talk to Maryanne Bishop about

Audubon as a possible grantor. RTP grants will open in September. Grants up to \$100,000 can be awarded for non-motorized trails. Requires a 10% match.

- 3) Eyak Mountain Trail: SCA will probably not be available this summer. Will utilize grant monies for material, supplies and local volunteer efforts, including paid positions if qualified people become available. Dave Zastrow will continue working with Erin Cole re tools and possible use of SCA or other trail personnel with availability at the end of the season.
  
- 4) Health Fair: We will have a booth at the Health Fair to get sign-ups for a volunteer list. Stormy Haught and Toni Godes will man the table from 8-10am, Liz Senear and Michelle Hahn from 10am-Noon. Dave will provide the easels and stands; Toni will put together a computer slid show; Stormy will provide copies of the Cordova Trail Plan and materials for the easels. Would like to generate a large map of the area which can be posted at future events.
  
- 5) Grant Proposals: Trail Capacity Grant Proposals are due by May 15. Tyler Tulloch will write a grant proposal for a storage shed and tools. Dave Zastrow will put together a tool list for the grant proposal.
